DIRECTIONS

Role Story: The writing activity with dice is an excellent way to get your students imaginations going for a writing assignment that is determined by the role of a die.

It is a simple game that is easy to follow for elementary school students.

- **Step 1:** Have student's role the die to determine what character they are. Repeat this action to determine the setting of the story and other elements such as where, when, what, and why.
- **Step 2:** Once the students each have the basics of their story determined they can write them down on the story outline cards provided.
- **Step 3:** Finally students should use the writing paper to construct a story with a beginning, middle, and end.







